We can admire the dedication of the athletes. No one becomes a world class swimmer or track and field athlete without years of practice and countless hours in the pool or on the track. St. Paul calls us to "run with perseverance the race that is set before us". This is our challenge as committed Christians.

Plans are also in place for a 2009 outreach to Torbeck, Haiti, January 30-February 8. The team will work in partnership with Haitian builders to complete construction of the Torbeck Methodist School. They will stay in a comfortable Methodist guesthouse in Jeremie. They will see life in the village up close and will experience extraordinary hospitality from people who are deeply grateful to have a school for their children close at hand. The estimated cost of the trip is \$1,350. This includes: round trip airfare to Haiti from Richmond and one RT in-country flight; room and board, coordination fee and \$25,000 insurance with a Medivac provision.
